HOW TO GET TO FREDRIKSTAD

BY PLANE

The nearest airports to Fredrikstad are:

- Oslo Gardermoen (OSL)
- Sandefjord (TORP)

Check websites in your country that compare different airlines for flying with the best deal, like <u>Skyscanner</u>.

BY CAR

Take the E6 southbound from Oslo and from Råde, you follow the signs to Fredrikstad on highway 110. If you drive from the South or West parts of Norway, it might be easier to take the ferry from Horten to Moss, rather than drive through the Oslo area.

At Oslo Airport you can find multiple car rental companies – see here.

BY BUS

There are frequent services from Oslo and Oslo Airport Gardermoen to Fredrikstad bus terminal operated by the company Vy Buss. From Oslo, it takes about 1 hr 20 minutes, while from Oslo Airport Gardermoen, approximately 2 hrs, and the cost is between € 30 and € 40.

BY TRAIN AND FERRY

There is also a good train service to and from Oslo. Departures are every hour from Oslo Central Station, and every half hour during rush hour. During the summer season, there are daily boats to Strømstad, Sweden, both from Fredrikstad and from the Hvaler Islands. City center ferry and river crossing; to and from the Fortified town, has frequent services from the early hours of the morning until late.

HOW TO GET BACK FROM LERWICK

BY FERRY

To get to the main inhabited islands from the Shetland Mainland, Shetland Islands Council operate an inter-island ferry service. The services are fast and frequent, and you can travel to all of them as a foot passenger and many of them with your own vehicle.

BY PLANE

The inter-island flight service operated by <u>Airtask Group</u> makes it easy to go 'island-hopping' to some of Shetland's more remote locations.

Flights depart from Tingwall airport (just 6 miles outside Lerwick) flying direct to <u>Fair</u> <u>Isle</u>, <u>Foula</u>, and <u>Papa Stour</u>. Flight timetables are available on the <u>Airtask</u> website.

BY BUS

Bus services within Shetland are provided by Zetland Transport Partnership and operated by several different operators.

From Tingwall airport you can easily reach Lerwick by bus, line number 9. There are buses daily from 08:06 am until 07:42 pm. We recommend you check the schedules <u>HERE</u>
