

HOW TO GET TO ESBJERG

For traveling to Esbjerg we recommend you first get to Copenhagen, where there are more flight and train connections, and then take a train to Esbjerg.

Copenhagen – Esbjerg by train

Train from Copenhagen to Esbjerg takes around 3h, operated by Danish Railways, and it costs 28 euros. Train service departs from København H and arrives in Esbjerg St. There are trains daily from 05:25 am until 7 pm. Weekend and holiday schedules can vary so we recommend you to check in advance here: <https://www.dsb.dk/en/>



This is the most popular choice for international travellers, but you have other options:

By taxi

By car

From Esbjerg you easily reach northern Europe and Scandinavia by car. Esbjerg is situated on the E20 highway and is only an hour drive from Germany.





Once you are in Esbjerg you can take the 11 Public Bus line Fanøfærgen - Bybusterminalen – Sædding to get to the berth where the ships will be moored. From the train station it takes 10 minutes.

HOW TO GET BACK HOME FROM HARLINGEN

In order to travel back home from Harlingen, we recommend taking a train to Amsterdam, and once there, a train or flight to your final destination.

Train

If you are traveling from Harlingen to Amsterdam by train, you will need to make a change in Leeuwarden. Train from Harlingen to Leeuwarden takes around 25 min and costs €5-8, and then from Leeuwarden to Amsterdam Centraal would be around 2 hours and costs around €20-30. That train involves a transfer in Almere station – check prices and timetables [here](#).

Once you get to Amsterdam Centraal, if you are traveling back home by plane, you can take the intercity train from Centraal to Schipol Airport. There are connections every 20 minutes departing from Centraal to Schipol, it takes 15-20 minutes and the price is €5. If you are traveling by train, Amsterdam Centraal has several international connections, check destinations, prices and timetables [here](#).
